Register of Interests of Members and Co-opted Members of the Council

Under Section 81 of the Local Government Act 2000, the Council's Monitoring Officer is responsible for establishing and maintaining a register of financial and other interests of the members and any co-opted members of the Council.

The register can be inspected by contacting the Corporate Head - Legal and Democratic Services at the offices of Lewes District Council at Lewes House, 32 High Street, Lewes, East Sussex BN7 2LX between the hours of 8.30am to 5.00pm Monday to Thursday and 8.30am to 4.30pm on Fridays.

All members of the Council are informed of their obligation to inform the Council's Monitoring Officer of any changes to their interests and the Monitoring Officer will record those changes in the register as soon as practicable.

The availability of the register, and the address at which it may be seen, has been advertised in a newspaper circulating in the area of Lewes District.
