CARAVAN SITES AND CONTROL OF DEVELOPMENT ACT 1960 PUBLIC HEALTH ACT 1936

CONDITIONS FOR THE ISSUE OF A LICENCE FOR USE OF LAND AS A CARAVAN OR CAMPING SITE

1. The licence shall relate to the area of land which is the subject of planning permission reference.....
2. The licence shall expire on 31 December....., or upon expiry of planning permission reference..... whichever is the sooner.
3. The site shall comply with the Council's standard conditions of licence contained in the schedule attached hereto. (The definition of site for this purpose shall be that land for which planning approval has been granted and which can reasonably be used to fulfil the requirements of the licence conditions).

General Notes

The schedules of standard conditions attached hereto relate to the following types of site:-

- a. Residential sites for more than one caravan
- b. Residential sites for one caravan only
- c. Holiday sites for more than one caravan
- d. Holiday sites for one caravan only
- e. Short-term transit camping sites
- f. Sites for which a licence is issued in special circumstances for periods not exceeding three years
