Please do

- Place the right items in the correct container as this helps keep the quality when sorted and sold
- Rinse out all cans, bottles and jars and remove the lids
- Plastic bottles can be washed, squashed flat and the lid screwed back on
- Recycle little and often

If the recycling banks are full please come back another day.

Please do not leave items for recycling on the floor, instead sort and place in the correct container and do not include anything in a plastic bag.

Be aware

Lewes District Council will take action against those who fly-tip or dispose of waste unlawfully. We want people to recycle and lawfully dispose of household and industrial waste.

- You can be prosecuted for fly-tipping
- Fines can be imposed
- You can be imprisoned
- If you use a waste contractor to get rid of waste then they should be registered with the Environment Agency and carry a permit

Please do not leave cardboard boxes, refuse, packaging or other waste. If you do have cardboard to recycle please take it to the nearest Household Waste and Recycling Site.
